I hope that you all have a restful and enjoyable half term break.

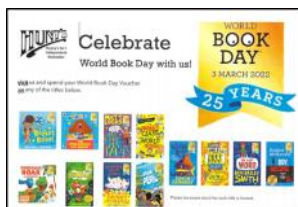

This year each class has chosen their favourite book and the day before they will be creating their own costume in school to wear on World Book Day.

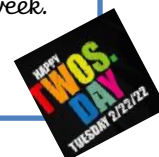
