Snapchat has a <u>Family Centre</u> feature and the company has been adding a couple of updates recently which parents may find useful, this includes seeing what friends their children have been sending messages to and a complete list of their child's existing friends.

WhatsApp: 16

What does the feature do?

See which Snapchat friends their children have sent messages, photos, or videos to in the last seven days, in a way that still protects the teens' privacy by not revealing the actual contents of their conversations (Snaps and messages)

See a complete list of their children's existing friends. Allow parents to easily view new friends their children have added, making it easy to

start conversations about who their new contacts are

Easily and confidentially report any accounts parents may be concerned about directly to their 24/7 Trust and Safety teams to investigate

Access key explainers about how to use these tools; resources for important
