Purpose of Study

All state schools are also required to make provision for a daily act of collective worship and must teach religious education to pupils at every key stage and sex and relationship education to pupils in secondary education.

Religious education for children and young people:

- **provokes challenging questions** about the meaning and purpose of life, beliefs, the self, issues of right and wrong, and what it means to be human. It develops pupils' knowledge and understanding of Christianity, other principal religions, and religious traditions that examine these questions, fostering personal reflection and spiritual development.
- encourages pupils to explore their own beliefs (whether they are religious or non-religious), in the light of what they learn, as they examine issues of religious belief and faith and how these impact on personal, institutional and social ethics; and to express their responses. This also builds resilience to anti-democratic or extremist narratives.
- enables pupils to build their sense of identity and belonging, which helps them flourish within their communities and as citizens in a diverse society
- teaches pupils to develop respect for others, including people with different faiths and beliefs, and helps to challenge prejudice.
- prompts pupils to consider their responsibilities to themselves and to others, and to explore how they might contribute to their communities and to wider society. It encourages empathy, generosity and compassion. RE has an important part to play as part of a broad, balanced and coherent curriculum to which all pupils are entitled.

Subject Content

Children will learn about the 6 main religions: Christianity, Sikhism, Hinduism, Judaism, Islam and Buddihism.

Children will develop a fundamental understanding of the key knowledge about each religion to allow them to explore a key question from a mastery position.

Within these religious, the children will learn about:

- Main Beliefs and Values symbols, clothing, main beliefs
- How do they worship
- Places of worship
- Holy books
- Key figures
- Pilgrimages
- Festivals

Children will use this knowledge and understanding to investigate, discuss and explore key questions. Children will develop a mastery approach towards the subject. Children will compare and contrast religions, as well as their own.

The curriculum has been designed in line with the LA Agreed Program of Study through SACRE.
